As a parishioner of the church, you have the right to elect your Parochial Church Council and we have 3 vacancies on the PCC and 2 on the Deanery synod this year.

This is your church, don't let your voice go unheard.

If you want to attend this meeting and vote your name needs to be on the Church Electoral Roll. The roll is now due for revision before the APCM which means you need to take one of the following actions TODAY.

1. If your name is already on the roll you need to check that your details are correct.
2. For your name to be added to the roll you need
 - to have reached the age of 16,
 - moved into the parish,
 - become a member of the church, worshipping here regularly.
