

# Lent, Holy Week and Easter at KCM 2026

## Passion Sunday 22 March

- 0930 **Sung Eucharist**
- 1100 **Morning worship** with Uniformed Organisations parade service
- 1700 **Cross of Christ Service** – a service of music and readings which tell the story of the crucifixion.



## Palm Sunday 29 March

- 0930 **Sung Eucharist** with Palm Procession, Blessing of Palm Crosses and the Passion reading
- 1100 **Cafe Church** – looking at the evidence for Jesus



## Holy Week

### Monday 30 March

- 0900 – 1300 **Holy Week Quiet morning**, ending with the Eucharist. Come aside from all the normal tasks of the day, and spend some time in quiet contemplation, preparing yourself to walk with Jesus through Holy Week
- 2000 **Cocoa and Compline** – Join us on-line for this short meditative service, giving thanks for the day that has been and asking God to protect us through the night.

- 2000 **Cocoa and Compline** – Join us on-line for this short meditative service, giving thanks for the day that has been and asking God to protect us through the night.




## Wednesday 1 April

**An Hour at the Cross** – a quiet time of reflections on the cross to include music, prayer, space, images and words as we meditate on the final hours of Christ's life.

**The Final Hour** – a moving service with readings and hymns as we hear again the account of Jesus' suffering and death.

**Messy Church Good Friday** – come along and make an Easter garden and hear again the story of Easter – in the vicarage garden if the weather is fine.



## Easter Eve 4 April

2000


**Service of Light** – together we anticipate the joy of Easter Day. The service starts in darkness before we go out to light the new light which is used to light the paschal candle which is then carried into the darkened Church where we all renew our baptismal vows, the light is passed through the church, and we celebrate that Christ is Risen.
